

### **General Note**

For Club Entries, will Clubs please make their members fully aware of GNAS Rule 307– Dress Regulations. This requirement also applies to other multiple and individual entries

Part of this Rule requires Members of the Society shooting and officiating at tournaments granted National or World Record Status by GNAS, are required to wear the accepted dress of the Society.

Colours – The accepted dress of the Society is plain dark green or white. There is no objection to wearing green and white garments together. A Club, County, Region, Affiliated Association or Sponsoring Archery Retailer may register alternative shooting colours with the Society.

Any archer not conforming to GNAS Rule 307 shall be required by the Judge and Tournament Organiser to leave the Shooting Line and will not be permitted to take part in the competition.

8. Holders of trophies are requested to return them at, or before the tournament.
9. GNAS policy requires anyone wishing to use photographic/video equipment must register with the tournament organiser.
